

## Trees



Acacia floribunda 'Gossamer wattle' - an ornamental dense spreading shrub to 4m tall, long bright green phyllodes, scented pale yellow flower spikes occur in Spring, tolerant of some shade and is frost resistant.



Callistemon sp. 'Eureka' - upright shrub to 5m high, bright red new growth, brilliant hot pink/purple brushes in Spring, tolerant of frost.



Eremophila bignoniiflora x polyclada - hardy shrub for a dry spot reaching 4m high, long narrow leaves, prolific large mauve tubular flowers much of the year, tolerant of frost and heavy soils.



Eucalyptus leucoxylon macrocarpa - ornamental tree to 8m, attractive trunk and large reddish pink flowers in Spring, recommended for windbreaks, grows well in heavy soils, frost resistant.



Eucalyptus pulverulenta Silver mountain gum - small shrubby tree to 4m, round silver foliage, suitable for floral work, ribbony white bark, clay and frost tolerant.



Eucalyptus scoparia Wallangarra white gum - fast growing ornamental tree to 15m, smooth straight white trunk, willow like olive green foliage, frost and drought resistant.



Pittosporum angustifolium Gumbi Gumbi - graceful shrub or small tree to 6m, weeping green foliage, small pale yellow flowers in Spring followed by orange capsules which split to reveal sticky red seeds, medicinal properties attributed to the leaves for cancer treatment, frost resistant.

## Large shrubs



Baeckea sp. 'Clarence River' - a hardy open shrub reaching 2m in height, fine dark green leaves on pendulous branches, showy with tiny white flowers during Summer, tolerant of frost and moist soils.



Callistemon sp. 'Mary MacKillop' - dense hardy shrub to 2.5m tall, weeping branches of soft green foliage, cardinal red bottlebrushes from Spring till Autumn, moderate frost tolerance only.



Callistemon pungens - hardy shrub to 3m, broad dark green leaves with silvery new growth, 6 cm long purple brushes in Spring, frost resistant.



Grevillea sp. 'Flora Mason' - fast growing shrub to 3m, fine grey green divided foliage, pink and yellow spider flowers in Spring, relatively tolerant of alkaline soils, moderate frost tolerance.



Grevillea sp. 'Pink Pearl' (syn. G. 'Canberra gem') - dense shrub to 2m, prickly foliage, reddish pink flower clusters most of the year, frost resistant.



Grevillea sp. 'Splendour' - hardy shrub to 3m, dark green pointed leaves, large ruby red flower clusters most of the year, frost resistant, useful for hedges, part shade.



Hovea lanceolata - 2m tall neatly shaped rounded shrub, long dark green leaves, glossy above, downy below, masses of purple pea flowers in Spring, frost and drought tolerant, prefers some shade; grows well under eucalypts.



Leptospermum polygalifolium Jelly bush - a hardy shrub to 3m, narrow tea-tree foliage, white flowers in Spring, frost resistant, produces honey with similar medicinal properties to Manuka honey.

## Small shrubs



Boronia megastigma Brown boronia - an open plant to 1.5m tall, fine aromatic foliage, perfumed brown and yellow flowers in Winter and Spring, requires a moist friable well drained position, tolerates frost.



Callistemon pachyphyllus var. viridis - useful bottlebrush growing to only 1.5m tall, narrow green foliage, very large green flower spikes occur in bunches throughout the year, tolerates poor drainage and frost.



Callistemon sp. 'Pink Alma' - compact shrub growing 1.5m x 1.5m, oval green leaves with pink new growth, good display of mid pink brushes in Spring and again in Autumn, frost tolerant.



Callistemon citrinus 'White Anzac' - attractive dense shrub to 1.5m, oval green leaves, white bottlebrushes in Spring and Autumn, frost resistant.



Correa mannii - neat shrub to 1m, small dark green heart shaped leaves, salmon red bell like flowers from Autumn-Spring, frost tolerant.



Eremophila maculata aurea - spreading shrub to 1.5m high by 2m wide, narrow dark green leaves, clear yellow tubular flowers over a long period, tolerant of frost and heavy soils.



Eutaxia obovata - rounded shrub to 1m high x 60 cm wide, green lanceolate leaves, yellow and red pea flowers in Spring, frost tolerant.

## Small shrubs



*Grevillea diminuta* - spreading shrub to 1m, ornamental metallic coloured oval leaves, rusty red pendulous flower clusters in Spring, frost resistant, sun or part shade.



*Grevillea* sp. 'Poorinda Elegance' - dense shrub to 1m, small dark green leaves, apricot and red spider flowers over a long period, tolerant of lime and frost.



*Melaleuca lateritia* Robin redbreast bush - erect and open shrub to 1.5m, soft linear green leaves, large outstanding orange brushes inside the shrub in late Spring and Summer, frost resistant.



*Melaleuca thymifolia* 'White Lace' - hardy compact shrub to 50 cm high, fine greyish green foliage, delicate lacy white flowers most of the year, frost resistant.



*Philotheca myoporoides* (long leaf form) Native wax flower - shrub to 1.5m, aromatic green leaves, pink buds and white starry flowers in Winter and Spring, tolerant of partial shade, frost resistant.



*Westringia* sp. 'Zena' - small compact form of Coastal Rosemary- grey foliage, white flowers, ideal for hedging, frost resistant.



*Xanthorrhoea glauca* (green form) Grasstree - relatively fast growing grasstree with a potential spread of 3m, the skirt consists of tough green leaves, tall woody flower spikes occur from June to Nov, irregularly, frost resistant, enjoys fertile basalt soils.

## Groundcovers



*Grevillea* sp. 'Carpet Queen' - dainty prostrate plant, small pointed leaves similar to G. Poorinda Queen, apricot/orange spider flowers in Winter, Spring and Summer, frost resistant.



*Grevillea curviloba* (syn. *biternata*) - vigorous ground cover, fine prickly lime green leaves, small scented white flowers in Spring, tolerant of frost.



*Grevillea* sp. 'Winter Delight' - hardy groundcover reaching 30 cm tall x 1.5m across, soft grey linear leaves, showy red and cream flowers in Winter and Spring, frost resistant.



*Hardenbergia* sp. 'Happy Wanderer' - vigorous and hardy twining creeper, green heart shaped leaves, small panicles of violet pea flowers in Spring, moderately frost hardy.



*Myoporum parvifolium* (pink) - hardy prostrate groundcover, small fleshy green leaves, pale pink starry flowers, moist position, tolerates some shade, frost resistant.
